


HIGHLIGHTS

DAY 0: ARRIVAL DAY


Kindly let us know if you'll need transportation and accommodation in Arusha before or after the safari; these can be included in your package. Our Tanzania Safari Guide will meet you at your lodge/hotel in Arusha either a day prior or in the morning to give you a short overview of the safari.



DAY 1: ARUSHA TO TARANGIRE NATIONAL PARK

Covering a 120 km distance in a 2 to 3-hour drive, after breakfast, we'll collect you from your lodge in Arusha and journey towards Tarangire National Park. The road passes through Arusha town, allowing for any last-minute shopping. Tarangire National Park is renowned for its significant elephant population and immense baobab trees. The park is home to around 6,000 elephants, 2,500 wildebeests, and 3,000 zebras. These diverse animals move around the Tarangire Lake Manyara ecosystem. The park's main water sources, Tarangire River and Lake Burunge Dam, support a wide variety of wildlife, especially during dry periods.

Expect to see lions, leopards, hyenas, jackals, cheetahs, buffaloes, giraffes, wildebeests, zebras, and rare species such as the Great kudu, Oryx, and the Ash stalling. Bird lovers will be delighted as the park houses over 400 bird species, including ostriches, herons, Cori bastards, secretary birds, and numerous water birds. Lunch will be provided within the park. Later, we'll drive to Migombani Campsite near Lake Manyara for an overnight stay, inclusive of all meals.



DAY 2: TARANGIRE TO NGORONGORO CRATER AND RETURN TO ARUSHA

The word Serengeti means endless plains in the language of the Maasai, which is exactly what you will see the coming days; miles and miles of African savannah! And trust us: it might be the most impressive landscape you will ever see. Of course, Serengeti National Park is home to an enormous variety of wildlife, which is why some many nature documentaries where shot here.

Submerge yourself in this unique landscape, while wildebeests and zebras pass you by in their Great Migration. Spot lions on groups of rocks called kopjes, leopards in single trees or cheetahs hunting for a calf in between the wildebeests. Pass by giraffes, hippos, crocodiles, gazelles and a vervet cat or wild dog if you are lucky. The epitome of romance you can experience in a hot air balloon above these plains (which can even have the shape of a heart!).

Have a lovely overnight in a luxury safaritent, with a staff that knows how to give newly weds just that bit of extra during dinner for example. Cuddle up at night while listening to the distant roar of a lion or the bellowing of the Great Migration herds. This is the true safari experience! Subsequently you will pass through the Ngorongoro Highlands on your way to or from Serengeti, an impressive landscape where you might run into groups of giraffes or some members of resident Maasai tribes.
