

- Enjoy the luxury and comfort of lodge accommodations, providing a relaxing retreat after each day's adventure.






ARRIVE IN TANZANIA

Covering a distance of 50 km, upon landing at Kilimanjaro International Airport, our representative will greet you, and a short 2 to 3-hour drive will take you to Planet Lodge in Arusha. Here, a safari briefing awaits from our manager. Set against the backdrop of Mt. Meru, the lodge offers breathtaking views of both the Meru and Kilimanjaro Mountains. Spend the night at Planet Lodge in Arusha, enjoying dinner and breakfast.



DAY 1: ARUSHA TO TARANGIRE NATIONAL PARK

Traversing 130 km with a non-game viewing time of 2 to 3 hours, kick off your adventure with a post-breakfast meeting with your safari guide. Depart Tarangire National Park via Arusha town for any last-minute needs. Renowned for its stunning landscape and substantial elephant population, Tarangire boasts the impressive Tarangire River and iconic baobab trees. Witness the annual migration of over 3000 elephants, wildebeest, and zebras. Spot giraffes, buffaloes, zebras, hippos, and rare species like Lesser and Greater Kudu. Evening drive to the lodge for dinner and overnight at Sangaiwe Tented Camp.

- Overnight at Sangaiwe Tented Camp near the park



DAY 2: TARANGIRE TO LAKE MANYARA TO LAKE EYASI

Covering Tarangire to Manyara (50 km), Manyara to Lake Eyasi (80 km), with a non-game viewing time of 1 to 2 hours, start your day with a drive to Lake Manyara National Park. Located in a dramatically green location, Manyara's diverse habitats and permanent water supply attract a myriad of wildlife. After lunch, continue to Lake Eyasi for a cultural encounter with the Datoga tribe, known as 'The blacksmith.' Explore their homes, ask questions, and visit the blacksmith. Enjoy a lakeside sunset walk before returning to the lodge for dinner and overnight.

- Overnight at Lake Eyasi Safari Lodge near the Lake



DAY 3: LAKE EYASI TO SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK

Covering 170 km with a non-game viewing time of 3 to 4 hours, start your day with an early morning hunting experience with the Bushman tribe. Depart for Serengeti National Park, passing through the highlands of Karatu and the Ngorongoro highlands. Visit a Masai village en route for a glimpse into their customary life, complete with traditional songs and dances. Check in at the Serengeti gate, enjoy breathtaking views of the crater floor, and drive to Nabii Hills gate for check-in. Begin your en-route game drive, possibly encountering the Great Wildebeest Migration. Reach your camp for dinner and overnight.

- Overnight at Serengeti Thorn Trees Camp in Central Serengeti or similar



DAY 4: FULL DAY IN SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK

Get on an early morning game drive to spot the cat family and observe the morning behaviours of other animals. If the Great Wildebeest Migration is present, spend time with the herds, anticipating various actions. Break for breakfast in the bush, continue the game drive until lunchtime, and explore Serengeti's beauty. Optional: Consider the famous Serengeti Balloon Safari (extra cost) or continue with full-day game drives. Return to camp during or before sunset for dinner and overnight.

- Overnight at Serengeti Thorn Trees Camp in Central Serengeti



DAY 5: SERENGETI TO NGORONGORO CRATER

Covering 178 km with a non-game viewing time of 2 to 3 hours, depart for Ngorongoro Crater. Enjoy an en-route game drive, reach Naabi Hills gate for checkout, and descend 600 meters into the Crater floor for a fantastic game drive. Picnic lunch in one of the crater's picnic sites, spot diverse wildlife including wildebeests, zebras, hippos, and the rare black rhino. Explore Lake Magadi and drive to the lodge for sunset, dinner, and overnight.

DAY 6: NGORONGORO TO ARUSHA

Covering 154 km with a non-game viewing time of 3 to 4 hours, enjoy a leisurely morning, have breakfast, and optionally a guided nature walk along the Enduro trail. Back for lunch before driving back to Arusha for an overnight stay (on your own account) or a drop-off at Kilimanjaro International Airport. Consider late flights for departure.
